

The Cambridge Foundation 2021 Grants:

After spending over \$275,000.00 for drainage abatement and improvements during 2020, the Cambridge Foundation has granted the sum of \$125,000.00 to Lake Ripley Park for a new playground and continued park improvements.

Cambridge Community Activities Program: \$9,800.00 representing \$1,000.00 for Care Scholarships, \$2,000.00 for materials and furniture, \$200.00 for additional hydroponic systems, \$1,500.00 for youth center free snack program, \$3,600.00 for senior luncheons, and \$1,500.00 toward submersible water rescue manikins.

Village of Cambridge: \$13,150.00 representing \$9,000.00 toward the electrical work for the Village shed, \$1,150.00 for speed sign maintenance and \$3,000.00 for Christmas decorations.

Cambridge Historic School Foundation: \$10,000.00 for general use.

Cambridge Community Library: \$2,250.00 for service window replacement.

Cambridge Public Schools: \$25,000.00 representing a contribution toward your building projects.

Cambridge Area Resource Team (CART): \$15,000.00
