## Cambridge Foundation Grants for year 2023:

Village of Cambridge the total sum of \$37,213.00 consisting of \$13,677.00 for installation of the Flag Pole in Veterans Park, \$1,026.00 for electric service to the light the flag, \$8,500.00 for cleaning and debris removal from Koshkonong Creek from Highway 18 to Highway 12., and \$14,010.00 for continued upgrading of electrical services to Veterans Park.

Cambridge Public School the sum of \$800.00 to sponsor Badger Boys and Badger Girls State.

Cambridge Food Pantry the sum of \$2,583.63 representing purchase of hams for the holiday baskets.

Cambridge Area Recreation Program the sum of \$7,400.00 consisting of \$1,200.00 for sponsorship of a variety of programming, \$2,500.00 to assist with the free snack program at the Youth Center, \$3,000.00 to assist with expenses associated with the senior citizen luncheons, and \$700.00 to fund CAP CARE scholarships.

Cambridge Music Boosters the sum of \$500.00 for continued support of the Cambridge Public Schools music programming.

Cambridge Area Resource Team (CART) the sum of \$15,000.00 to assist with funding a part of the social worker contract in partnership with the School District of Cambridge.

Cambridge Community Library the sum of \$1,200.00 to assist with the upgrade safety shields and safety glass partitions.

Cambridge Arts Council the sum of \$6,500.00 in matching funds earmarked to offset expenses of materials and fees associated with the creation of public art.

Utica Community Association the sum of \$5,000.00 to assist in the construction of a new shelter at the ball field for shade and a picnic area for families.

Lake Ripley Management District the sum of \$15,000.00 to assist with the purchase and installation of a 135 foot boardwalk in the District's Preserve.

Cambridge Historic School Foundation the sum of \$18,500.00 for assistance toward a variety of building restoration projects.
